

Electronic Land Registration Soon to Replace Paper in Prince Edward

Effective **Monday December 17, 2007**, it will be required that the majority of land registrations in the Prince Edward Land Registry Office be submitted electronically.

The Prince Edward legal community initially gained access to the electronic land registration system on August 21, 2006, when electronic land registration became available on an optional basis.
